



requires reviewing the program after two years. Legislative Council and Joint Budget Committee staff believe that the data for a basic review of the size and costs of the program will be readily available from the Department of State at that time. As a result, staff believes that the accountability clause does not have a significant impact on the expenditures that would be necessary to implement the bill. If, however, the review involves examination of the program in greater detail, more in keeping with the type of analysis done by the State Auditor, then there may be significant expenses when the accountability study occurs.
