TITLE: CONCERNING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION'S DUTY TO PROMULGATE RULES REGULATING CARRIERS EXEMPT FROM REGULATION AS A PUBLIC UTILITY.

Summary of Assessment

The re-engrossed bill removes several current statutory provisions regulating luxury limousine services and authorizes the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC) to promulgate rules governing the operational requirements for such services. This bill becomes effective July 1, 2007.

Proposed changes involving PUC rulemaking related to limousines can be accomplished within the normal course of business and will not require added resources or staff, nor does PUC staff expect any change in the number of carriers. Given this information, this bill will not affect state or local revenues or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
