TITLE: CONCERNING AN ALERT PROGRAM FOR MISSING PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

Summary of Assessment

This bill adds missing persons with developmental disabilities to the existing alert program for missing senior citizens and, in effect, the Amber Alert Program that broadcasts child abductions. The missing person's family or service provider is required to provide documentation of the missing person's disability when making a report to local law enforcement. Then, local law enforcement notifies the Colorado Bureau of Investigation who issues an alert to media outlets in Colorado. The Governor signed the bill into law on February 16, 2007.

This bill is expected to only marginally increase workload in the Department of Public Safety. Thus, the bill can be implemented using existing resources, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
