TITLE: CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF OUTDATED PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE RESULTING FROM THE LAW'S OBSOLESCENCE OR INFREQUENCY OF USE, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REPEALING OR AMENDING VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF LAW.

Summary of Assessment

This bill eliminates several outdated provisions of law related to the Department of Revenue. Since the bill does not affect state or local revenue or expenditures, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Specific provisions of the bill include the following:

- repeals the mechanisms that refund excess state revenue through an income tax credit for contributions made to the Colorado Institute of Technology (which no longer exists);
- repeals the requirement that the Department of Revenue include in the income tax booklet a statement that the income tax rate was reduced in 1999 from 5.0% to 4.75%, and in 2000 from 4.75% to 4.63%;
- repeals the requirement that the Department of Revenue produce copies or digests of the provisions of Articles 1 to 4 of Title 42, C.R.S.;
- repeals the requirement that the department either publish or post on public bulletin boards in each of its offices a record of suspensions and revocations of drivers' licenses. The bill also repeals the requirement that the department furnish copies of those records to law enforcement offices throughout the state; and
- strikes language relating to a holder of a valid state garage license being able to operate, move, or transport a vehicle on streets and highways without registering the vehicle and without an attached numbered plate, so long as the vehicle had a depot tag issued by the department.

The bill becomes effective August 8, 2007, unless a referendum petition is filed, assuming the General Assembly adjourns on May 9, 2007, as scheduled.
