

Summary of Assessment

This bill expands the membership of the Sex Offender Management Board from 21 to 24 members. The bill requires one of the new members to be a county director of social services. The remaining two members are required to be county commissioners from an urban and rural county. All of the new members will be appointed by the executive director of the Department of Public Safety after consultation with a statewide group representing counties.

Since members of the Sex Offender Management Board serve without compensation or reimbursement for actual or necessary expenses, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill is effective upon the signature of the Governor.
