## **Summary of Assessment**

This bill authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to determine rates and practices for gas and electric service that account for the needs of low-income utility customers. "Low-income utility customer" is defined as a household with income at or below 185 percent of the federal poverty level.

• For a one-person household, the income level would be \$18,130.

• For a family of four, the income level would be \$37,000.

The bill becomes effective upon signature of the Governor.

This bill will not affect state or local government revenue or expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
