TITLE: CONCERNING RESTRICTING ACCESS BY A MINOR TO AN ARTIFICIAL TANNING

DEVICE.

Summary of Assessment

The bill prohibits anyone under 18 years of age from using an artificial tanning device unless prescribed by a physician. An owner, employee, or operator of a tanning facility or artificial tanning device is required to verify the age of a person seeking access to the device. The bill is effective upon signature of the Governor.

Under current law, the Department of Public Health and Environment, Consumer Protection Division, is responsible for the registration and regulation of artificial tanning devices. For the current fiscal year, \$63,850 cash funds is appropriated for these purposes. The requirements of SB07-023 will be incorporated into the routine inspection activities of the division with no new costs. Therefore, the bill is assessed at having no fiscal impact.
