### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING DUE PROCESS RIGHTS OF AFFECTED LANDOWNERS

102 RELATING TO THE SALVAGE OF GAS TRANSMISSION LINES.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Allows the public utilities commission to adopt rules for the salvage of gas transmission lines, including notice and an opportunity to be heard for affected landowners prior to the salvage.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. 40-4-101, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
2	BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:
3	40-4-101. Rules, service, and facilities prescribed. (4) THE
4	COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT RULES FOR THE SALVAGE OF GAS
5	TRANSMISSION LINES. SAID RULES SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE AFFECTED
6	LANDOWNERS BE GIVEN REASONABLE NOTICE BEFORE THE SALVAGE OF
7	THE GAS TRANSMISSION LINE.
8	SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect at 12:01
9	a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after
10	final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting
11	a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state
12	constitution, (August 8, 2007, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2007);
13	except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item,
14	section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section,
15	or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the
16	official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
