# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING EXTENSION OF THE REPEAL DATE OF THE FOREST RESTORATION PILOT PROGRAM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, EXTENDING THE REPEAL DATE OF THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY PANEL, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

# **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Extends the repeal date for the forest restoration pilot program and the technical advisory panel to July 1, 2012.

24	restoration pilot program, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the
25	implementation of this act.
