TITLE: CONCERNING NOTIFICATION TO EMPLOYERS OF THE FEDERAL ELECTRONIC VERIFICATION PROGRAM FOR USE IN VERIFYING THE WORK ELIGIBILITY STATUS OF NEW EMPLOYEES.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires the Department of Labor and Employment to include a statement in its quarterly electronic publication distributed to all employers to notify employers of the federal law against hiring or continuing to employ an illegal alien. The exact wording, font style and placement of the notice are specified in the bill. The notice shall include information about the Electronic Verification Program jointly administered by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the Social Security Administration. The department and the Secretary of State will post the notification and information about the program on their web sites as well as a link to it. The Governor signed the bill into law on May 20, 2008, and unless a referendum petition is filed, the bill will take effect August 5, 2008.

Assessment

This bill is assessed at no fiscal impact. The department will add the notice to its quarterly electronic newsletter, the *UI Quarterly News*, that is sent to all employers. The department and Secretary of State will provide links on their web sites to the E-Verify web site. These activities do not require an additional appropriation.
