23	(c) Methods to reimburse any revenue losses to local

25	(3) THE TASK FORCE SHALL MEET AT LEAST SIX TIMES, WITH THE
26	FIRST MEETING OCCURRING NO LATER THAN AUGUST 1, 2009, TASK FORCE
27	MEETINGS SHALL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, AND THE TASK FORCE SHALL
28	SOLICIT THE TESTIMONY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

- 5 (b) THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF AND THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE LEGAL SERVICES SHALL NOT BE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST THE TASK FORCE IN CARRYING OUT ITS DUTIES.
- 8 (5) No later than November 1, 2009, the task force may make a report to the general assembly that includes recommendations for legislation.
- 11 (6) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2010.
- SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
- 15 Page 1, strike lines 101 and 102 and substitute the following:
- 16 "CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A LEGISLATIVE TASK FORCE TO
- 17 STUDY PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR BUSINESS PERSONAL
