TITLE: CONCERNING GRANTING VOTING RIGHTS TO STUDENT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.**Summary of Legislation**

This bill gives voting rights to the two student members on the Board of Governors of the Colorado State University (CSU) system. These members currently serve in an advisory role. Student members on the board are appointed by the governor from nominees elected by the student body at each of the system campuses. Student members must be attending school full-time and be either juniors, seniors, or graduate students.

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Education Committee on February 9, 2009.

Assessment

This bill does not change the workload of the Department of Higher Education or the workload of employees in the CSU system. It merely gives voting rights to student members on the board. Thus, the bill does not affect state or local revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
