**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101     **CONCERNING A FEE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO**  
102             **BE USED TO SUPPORT THE COLORADO STATE TITLING AND**  
103             **REGISTRATION SYSTEM.**

**Bill Summary**

*(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)*

Imposes a 60-cent fee on the registration of motor vehicles, to be used to support the state titling and registration system.

1     *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1           **SECTION 1.** 42-3-304, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

3           **42-3-304. Registration fees - passenger and passenger-mile**  
4 **taxes - clean screen fund.** (25) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FEES  
5 IMPOSED BY THIS SECTION, THERE SHALL BE ASSESSED AN ADDITIONAL FEE  
6 OF SIXTY CENTS AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE.  
7 SUCH FEE SHALL BE TRANSMITTED TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL  
8 CREDIT IT TO THE COLORADO STATE TITLING AND REGISTRATION  
9 ACCOUNT, CREATED IN SECTION 42-1-211, WITHIN THE HIGHWAY USERS  
10 TAX FUND.

11           **SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** This act shall take  
12 effect July 1, 2009, and shall apply to registrations filed on or after said  
13 date.

14           **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
