A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF THE "NOTARIES PUBLIC ACT".

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Sunset Process - Senate State, Veteran, and Military Affairs Committee. Implements the recommendations of the department of regulatory agencies in its sunset review of the "Notaries Public Act" as follows:

- ! Continues the "Notaries Public Act" until July 1, 2018.
- ! Allows the secretary of state to suspend a notary public commission or issue a letter of admonition as a means of discipline.
- ! Requires a notary public to make a journal entry for each

- ! Adds elements to what constitutes a disqualifying interest for a notary public to perform a notarial act.
- ! Repeals the authority of a notary public to notarize notices of dishonor and presentment.

Authorizes the office of the secretary of state to promulgate rules to require that notaries public complete a training program.

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Pictorial notary public - secretary of state - rules. The secretary of state shall adopt rules necessary to establish standards, procedures, practices, forms, and records relating to the ability of notaries public to transmit encrypted, authenticated photographs of individuals for use by motor vehicle offices, credit card companies, and other entities requiring an authenticated photograph of an individual. The rules shall require the notary to maintain an encryption device or other technology enabling the notary to transmit photographs electronically and protect the security and authenticity of the photographs. The rules shall authorize the notary to charge a reasonable fee, not to exceed ten dollars, for each photograph electronically transmitted. The secretary of state shall adopt the rules as soon as administratively feasible. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 24-4-103 (5), C.R.S., the rules adopted pursuant to this section shall not take effect until the general assembly, acting by bill other than a bill enacted pursuant to section 24-4-103 (8) (c) (I), C.R.S., approves the rules. SECTION 8. 12-55-103.5, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read: **12-55-103.5.** Training - rules. (1) The office of the secretary of state may enter into a contract with a private contractor or contractors to conduct notary training programs. The contractor or contractors may charge a fee for any such training program.

(2) THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO REQUIRE NOTARIES PUBLIC TO COMPLETE A TRAINING PROGRAM.
