JBC Staff Concurrence with Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$46,017 cash funds from the Pet Animal Facilities Cash Fund and 1.0 FTE to the cash funds appropriation made to the Agricultural Services Division in the 2009 Long Bill to support the inspector position. However, due to a staff technical error, the appropriations clause added by the House failed to include \$3,636 cash funds associated with funding the additional inspector position. Amendment **J.004** (attached) corrects this technical error by amending the appropriations clause to appropriate \$49,653 cash funds, which is consistent with the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Impact dated April 24, 2009.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Sponsor amendment **L.016** (attached) extends the sunset date of the Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act five years to 2019, restoring the reengrossed version of the bill. The amendment does not change the fiscal impact of the bill as delineated in the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note dated April 24, 2009. **If L.016 is adopted amendment J.004 should still be adopted.**
