After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1209 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Finance with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and  
2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. 42-2-114, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended  
4 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

5 **42-2-114. License issued - fees - repeal.** (10) (a) AT THE  
6 APPLICANT'S VOLUNTARY REQUEST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A  
7 DRIVER'S LICENSE BEARING AN IDENTIFIER OF A BRANCH OF THE UNITED  
8 STATES ARMED FORCES, SUCH AS "MARINE CORPS", "NAVY", "ARMY",  
9 "AIR FORCE", OR "COAST GUARD", IF THE APPLICANT POSSESSES A  
10 CURRENTLY VALID MILITARY IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT, A DD214 FORM  
11 ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, OR ANY OTHER DOCUMENT  
12 ACCEPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT DEMONSTRATES THAT THE  
13 APPLICANT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR A VETERAN OF THE BRANCH OF  
14 SERVICE THAT THE APPLICANT HAS REQUESTED BE PLACED ON THE  
15 DRIVER'S LICENSE. THE APPLICANT SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE  
16 DOCUMENTATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR A  
17 VETERAN OF A BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES TO RENEW  
18 OR BE REISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE BEARING AN IDENTIFIER ISSUED  
19 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (10). THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT PLACE  
20 MORE THAN ONE BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES  
21 IDENTIFIER ON AN APPLICANT'S DRIVER'S LICENSE.

22 (b) (I) TO BE ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE BEARING A BRANCH OF  
23 SERVICE IDENTIFIER, THE APPLICANT SHALL PAY A FEE OF FIFTEEN

1 DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ANY  
2 OTHER FEE FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER  
3 THE FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE  
4 HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II)  
5 OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b).

6 (II) (A) THE DEPARTMENT MAY RETAIN UP TO NINETY-EIGHT  
7 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS OF THE FEES  
8 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b) AS  
9 NECESSARY TO OFFSET THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COST OF IMPLEMENTING  
10 THIS SUBSECTION (10).

11 (B) THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II) IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
12 2012.

13 (c) (I) THIS SUBSECTION (10) IS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011.

14 (II) THIS PARAGRAPH (c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011.

15 **SECTION 2.** 42-2-303, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended  
16 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

17 **42-2-303. Contents of identification card.** (4) (a) AT THE  
18 APPLICANT'S VOLUNTARY REQUEST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE AN  
19 IDENTIFICATION CARD BEARING AN IDENTIFIER OF A BRANCH OF THE  
20 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, SUCH AS "MARINE CORPS", "NAVY",  
21 "ARMY", "AIR FORCE", OR "COAST GUARD", IF THE APPLICANT POSSESSES  
22 A CURRENTLY VALID MILITARY IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT, A DD214  
23 FORM ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, OR ANY OTHER  
24 DOCUMENT ACCEPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT DEMONSTRATES THAT  
25 THE APPLICANT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR A VETERAN OF THE BRANCH OF  
26 SERVICE THAT THE APPLICANT HAS REQUESTED BE PLACED ON THE  
27 IDENTIFICATION CARD. THE APPLICANT SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO  
28 PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR  
29 A VETERAN OF A BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES TO  
30 RENEW OR BE REISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BEARING AN IDENTIFIER  
31 ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (4). THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT  
32 PLACE MORE THAN ONE BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES  
33 IDENTIFIER ON AN APPLICANT'S IDENTIFICATION CARD.

34 (b) TO BE ISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BEARING A BRANCH OF  
35 SERVICE IDENTIFIER, THE APPLICANT SHALL PAY A FEE OF FIFTEEN

1 DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ANY  
2 OTHER FEE FOR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL  
3 TRANSFER THE FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE  
4 TO THE HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND.

5 (c) (I) THIS SUBSECTION (4) IS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011.

6 (II) THIS PARAGRAPH (c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011.

7 **SECTION 3. Specified effective date - applicability.** This act  
8 shall take effect July 1, 2010, and shall apply to driver's licenses and  
9 identification cards issued on or after said date.

10 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."

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
