**Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$74,115 cash funds from the Public Utilities Commission Fixed Utility Fund and 0.6 FTE to the Department of Regulatory Agencies, Public Utilities Commission for FY 2010-11. Amendment J.001 reappropriates \$13,041 and appropriates 0.1 FTE to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services.
