**TITLE:** CONCERNING THE ORDER IN WHICH STATEWIDE BALLOT MEASURES APPEAR ON A BALLOT.

**Summary of Legislation**

The bill changes the order that statewide ballot measures appear on the ballot. Table 1 provides a summary of the order under current law and under the bill.

The bill was signed by the Governor and became law on June 10, 2010, and applies to ballot measures in the 2010 election.

**Assessment**

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Changing the order of ballot measures will not affect printing or postage costs for county clerks and will not increase workload in any state agency.
