After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1283 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Judiciary with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 2 through 11.

2 Strike pages 3 and 4.

3 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 17 and substitute:

4 "SECTION 1. Part 1 of article 36 of title 12, Colorado Revised
5 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to
6 read:

7 **12-36-114.5. Continuing professional development - rules.** ON
8 OR BEFORE THE 2013 PHYSICIAN LICENSURE RENEWAL CYCLE, THE BOARD
9 SHALL PROMULGATE AND IMPLEMENT BY RULE, AN ONGOING
10 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM THAT SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN
11 CONJUNCTION WITH AND IN AGREEMENT WITH STATEWIDE PROFESSIONAL
12 ASSOCIATIONS THAT REPRESENT PHYSICIANS AND PHYSICIAN
13 ASSISTANTS."

14 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

15 Page 6, line 22, strike the second "PROFESSIONAL".

16 Page 6, line 23, strike "COMPRISING SUCH HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS" and
17 substitute "THAT PROVIDES OR DELIVERS HEALTH CARE SERVICES".

1 Page 6, line 26, strike "A PERSON" and substitute "AN INDIVIDUAL".

2 Page 7, line 11, after the period add "EFFORTS TO VERIFY EMPLOYMENT
3 SHALL BE PRESUMED TO BE REASONABLE IF THE VERIFICATION
4 COMMUNICATION SUBMITTED TO THE PREVIOUS EMPLOYERS HAS
5 IDENTIFIED THE APPLICANT, INCLUDES A REQUEST FOR VERIFICATION OF
6 DATES OF EMPLOYMENT, REQUESTS THE POSITION HELD, AND MAKES
7 EXPRESS INQUIRIES AS TO THE PREVIOUS EMPLOYERS' POSSESSION OF THE
8 INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS
9 SECTION."

10 Page 7, line 12, after "(2) (a)" insert "(I)".

11 Page 7, line 16, strike "KNOWN ABOUT".

12 Page 7, strike lines 17 and 18 and substitute "IN ITS POSSESSION ABOUT
13 WORK PERFORMANCE AFFECTED BY DRUG OR ALCOHOL USE, ANY
14 VIOLATIONS OF ANY DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY, DRUG DIVERSION, DRUG
15 TAMPERING, PATIENT ABUSE, OR CRIMES OF VIOLENCE, AS LISTED IN
16 SECTION 18-1.3-406 (2) (a), C.R.S., COMMITTED BY AN APPLICANT.

17 (II) AS SOON AS A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER COMES INTO
18 POSSESSION OF INFORMATION ABOUT WORK PERFORMANCE AFFECTED BY
19 DRUG OR ALCOHOL USE, ANY VIOLATIONS OF ANY DRUG AND ALCOHOL
20 POLICY, DRUG DIVERSION, DRUG TAMPERING, PATIENT ABUSE, OR CRIMES
21 OF VIOLENCE, AS LISTED IN SECTION 18-1.3-406 (2) (a), C.R.S.,
22 COMMITTED BY A HEALTH CARE WORKER IN HIS OR HER EMPLOY, THE
23 HEALTH CARE PROVIDER SHALL DISCLOSE SUCH INFORMATION TO ANY
24 OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FOR WHOM THE EMPLOYEE IS KNOWN TO
25 PROVIDE SERVICES."

26 Page 11, line 2, after the period add "THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE INPUT
27 FROM PATIENT SAFETY ADVOCACY GROUPS."
