### <u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 01/13/10 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal</u> <u>Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Business Affairs and Labor Committee 02/03/10)</u>

The House Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report made the following changes:

- Required the Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation to develop the brochure that is distributed to claimants;
- Stipulated that the brochure can be distributed electronically;
- ► Made technical changes to language regarding the claimant's rights including who the claimant can have at medical appointments;
- Clarified that if the claimant wants to seek additional medical opinions the claimant will be financially responsible for the medical examination expenses; and,
- Clarified that the employer is responsible for continuing medical expenses, if appropriate.

JBC staff and Legislative Council Fiscal Note Staff agree that these changes do not impact the fiscal note.

#### **Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision reducing the Division of Workers' Compensation appropriation for FY 2010-11 by \$18,000 cash funds from the Division of Workers' Compensation Cash Fund.
