Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2010-11.

The Department of Revenue does not require an appropriation of \$4,158 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund for computer programming costs because the Long Bill includes an appropriation for the Department to implement legislation that requires computer programming hours. Programming costs in the Department to implement session legislation is shown in the Long Bill line item titled "Programming Costs for 2010 Session Legislation."
