<u>HB10-1147</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 6, line 6, strike "DEPARTMENTS".
- 2 Page 6, strike lines 7 through 16 and substitute:

3 "DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE 4 DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY AND APPROPRIATE 5 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS, SHALL NOTIFY 6 SCHOOLS OF THE AVAILABILITY OF AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOLS 7 EXISTING EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM FOR INDIVIDUALS UNDER EIGHTEEN 8 YEARS OF AGE REGARDING THE SAFE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND 9 PREMISES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC BY USERS OF NONMOTORIZED WHEELED 10 TRANSPORTATION AND PEDESTRIANS. THE CURRICULUM SHALL FOCUS ON, 11 AT A MINIMUM, INSTRUCTION REGARDING:".

- 13 Page 6, line 23, strike "TRAILS." and substitute "TRAILS; AND
- 14 (h) SAFE PEDESTRIAN PRACTICES.".
- 15 Page 8, strike lines 16 through 25 and substitute:

SAFETY INFORMATION CARDS SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED THROUGH
COLLABORATION BETWEEN LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND
APPROPRIATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS AND
MAY BE SUPPORTED BY THE DEPARTMENTS OF TRANSPORTATION,
EDUCATION, AND PUBLIC SAFETY.".

Page 9, line 14, after "VIOLATION." add "A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC
LANDOWNER OR LESSEE OF PREMISES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC SHALL HAVE NO
RESPONSIBILITY TO ENFORCE THIS SECTION. NEITHER SUCH A LANDOWNER
OR LESSEE NOR A LAW ENFORCEMENT OR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER NOR ANY
OTHER PERSON SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANY LEGAL LIABILITY FOR NOT
ENFORCING THIS SECTION.".

22 Page 1, line 105, strike "DEPARTMENTS OF".

Page 1, strike lines 106 through 108 and substitute "DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE DEPARTMENTS OF
EDUCATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY AND APPROPRIATE NONPROFIT
ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS, TO NOTIFY SCHOOLS OF THE
AVAILABILITY OF AND MAKE".

28 Page 1, line 109, strike "A COMPREHENSIVE" and substitute "EXISTING".
