After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1147 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 6, line 6, strike "DEPARTMENTS".
- 2 Page 6, strike lines 7 through 16 and substitute:
  - 3 "DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE
  - 4 DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY AND APPROPRIATE
  - 5 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS, SHALL NOTIFY
  - 6 SCHOOLS OF THE AVAILABILITY OF AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOLS
  - 7 EXISTING EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM FOR INDIVIDUALS UNDER EIGHTEEN
  - 8 YEARS OF AGE REGARDING THE SAFE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND
  - 9 PREMISES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC BY USERS OF NONMOTORIZED WHEELED
  - 10 TRANSPORTATION AND PEDESTRIANS. THE CURRICULUM SHALL FOCUS ON,
  - 11 AT A MINIMUM, INSTRUCTION REGARDING:".
- 12 Page 6, line 22, strike "AND".
- 13 Page 6, line 23, strike "TRAILS." and substitute "TRAILS; AND
- 14 (h) SAFE PEDESTRIAN PRACTICES.".
- 15 Page 8, strike lines 16 through 25 and substitute:
  - 16 "(b) THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION
  - 17 WITH THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY AND

1 APPROPRIATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS, SHALL  
2 DESIGN, DEVELOP, AND PRODUCE AN ELECTRONIC SAFETY INFORMATION  
3 CARD THAT CAN BE MODIFIED TO MATCH LOCAL NEEDS, PRINTED AT THE  
4 LOCAL LEVEL, AND PROVIDED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS  
5 SUBSECTION (3) AND SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN ELECTRONIC  
6 SAFETY INFORMATION CARD DISTRIBUTION PLAN, INCLUDING THE POSTING  
7 TO APPROPRIATE INTERNET WEB SITES OF THE ELECTRONIC SAFETY  
8 INFORMATION CARDS. THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF PRODUCING  
9 AND".

10 Page 9, line 1, after "ONLY." add "THE DISTRIBUTION OF HARD COPIES OF  
11 SAFETY INFORMATION CARDS SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED THROUGH  
12 COLLABORATION BETWEEN LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND  
13 APPROPRIATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS AND  
14 MAY BE SUPPORTED BY THE DEPARTMENTS OF TRANSPORTATION,  
15 EDUCATION, AND PUBLIC SAFETY.".

16 Page 9, line 14, after "VIOLATION." add "A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC  
17 LANDOWNER OR LESSEE OF PREMISES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC SHALL HAVE NO  
18 RESPONSIBILITY TO ENFORCE THIS SECTION. NEITHER SUCH A LANDOWNER  
19 OR LESSEE NOR A LAW ENFORCEMENT OR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER NOR ANY  
20 OTHER PERSON SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANY LEGAL LIABILITY FOR NOT  
21 ENFORCING THIS SECTION.".

22 Page 1, line 105, strike "**DEPARTMENTS OF**".

23 Page 1, strike lines 106 through 108 and substitute "**DEPARTMENT OF**  
24 **TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE DEPARTMENTS OF**  
25 **EDUCATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY AND APPROPRIATE NONPROFIT**  
26 **ORGANIZATIONS AND ADVOCACY GROUPS, TO NOTIFY SCHOOLS OF THE**  
27 **AVAILABILITY OF AND MAKE**".

28 Page 1, line 109, strike "**A COMPREHENSIVE**" and substitute "**EXISTING**".

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
