**TITLE:** CONCERNING EXTENDING THE REPEAL DATE FOR THE COLORADO COMMISSION FOR THE DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING.**Summary of Legislation**

HB10-1255 extends the repeal date for the Colorado Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, located in the Department of Human Services, until July 1, 2015. The bill takes effect on July 1, 2010.

**Assessment**

The bill is assessed at no fiscal impact, as it extends the existing operations and functions of the commission. The commission was appropriated \$793,850 and 2.8 FTE in FY 2009-10. The budget request for the commission in FY 2010-11 is \$1,043,820 and 5.8 FTE. This increase reflects the adoption of SB09-044, which increased the commission's staffing and funding.
