## Reason for the Update

Staff has updated the fiscal impact of S.B. 09-169 based on the appropriations recommended in the Joint Budget Committee's budget package. The updated analysis also assumes that the enhanced federal match rate in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) will be extended through June 30, 2011. Table 1 below summarizes the updated fiscal impact.

#### **Summary of Legislation**

Senate Bill 10-169 allows the Hospital Provider Fee Cash Fund to offset General Fund expenditures in the amount of the additional federal funds that are received from the enhanced federal match under ARRA in both FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11. However, in FY 2009-10 the Hospital Provider Fee Cash Fund is required to reimburse the Health Care Expansion Fund for the \$41.4 million that was

transferred to the General Fund in H.B. 10-1320 (Use of Tobacco Tax Fiscal Emergency FY 2009-10). Any funds in excess of the \$41.4 million in FY 2009-10 can then be used to offset General Fund expenditures. Staff estimates that \$4.9 million will be available in FY 2009-10 to offset General Fund expenditures. In FY 2010-11, a total of \$46.3 million in Hospital Provider Fee is estimated to be available to offset General Fund Expenditures. The calculations for these estimates are shown in the tables below.

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating funds to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing in FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11 as required under the provisions in the bill. ### **Points to Consider**

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has introduced a balanced budget package for FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11 based on the March 2010 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY FY 2009-10 budget balancing package \$4.9 million in General Fund savings from S.B. 10-169. In FY 2010-11, the JBC has included \$46.3 million in General Fund savings that would result from the passage of S.B. 10-169.
