Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 2/22/10 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the Agriculture, Livestock, and Natural Resources Committee 2/24/10)

The Agriculture, Livestock, and Natural Resources Committee Report made changes to the bill to require the Board of Parks and Outdoor Recreation to notify outfitters of inspections at least seventy-two hours in advance of the inspections and to notify outfitters of certain division personnel changes within ten days of the change.

The Report also required that the River Outfitter Advisory Committee review and make recommendations concerning any rules promulgated by the Board of Parks and Outdoor Recreation.

The Agriculture, Livestock, and Natural Resources Committee Report did not change the fiscal impact of the bill. Legislative Council staff concurs with this JBC staff assessment.
