## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill subjects persons who illegally divert surface water to the same \$500 maximum per day fine that currently applies to the illegal diversion of groundwater.

## **State Revenue**

General Fund revenue is expected to increase by approximately \$2,500 in FY 2010-11 and FY 2011-12 from the collection of fines. The actual amount will depend on the number and length of violations, and the fines levied by water judges.
