TITLE: CONCERNING THE DEMONSTRATION OF COMPETENCY BY AN OUT-OF-STATE

APPLICANT IN A FIELD REGULATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY

Summary of Legislation

Currently, certain health care professionals who are licensed in other states may be licensed in Colorado if they meet competency requirements demonstrated by time spent "in the field." This bill permits either the director of the Division of Registrations, in the Department of Regulatory Agencies, or the appropriate board to identify by rule an alternate set of criteria to demonstrate competency. This bill is effective July 1, 2011.

Assessment

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The director or appropriate board will determine the alternate set of criteria to demonstrate competency and pass any necessary rules. These licensure changes will be integrated into the application process. This may include making changes to applications, the licensing system, and website information. These tasks will be accomplished within the standard work of the department and no additional appropriations are necessary.
