TITLE: CONCERNING THE SOUTHERN UTE INDIAN TRIBE/STATE OF COLORADO ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REPEALING TERM LIMITS APPLICABLE TO THE COMMISSION AND REPEALING A MOOT CONDITION RELATED TO THE REPEAL OF THE COMMISSION.

Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals term limits for governor-appointed commissioners to the Southern Ute Indian Tribe / State of Colorado Environmental Commission. Obsolete language concerning the repeal of the commission is also removed.

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.

Assessment

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact for it does not create any work for a state or local government entity.
