## **Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$70,000 General Fund to the Department of Human Services for FY 2010-11. The funds will be used to hire an independent consultant to review the state's current behavioral health crisis response system and formulate a plan to address inefficiencies in the system.

## **Bill Sponsor Amendments**

Sponsor amendment **L.005** (attached) requires the Department of Human Services to implement the provisions of the bill within existing appropriations. This removes the General Fund cost of the bill. *If L.005 is adopted, J.001 should not be adopted.* 

## **Points to Consider**

The Joint Budget Committee has introduced a balanced budget package for FY 2010-11 based on the March 2010 Legislative Council Staff forecast. If **L.005** is not adopted and **J.001** is adopted, this bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$70,000 for FY 2010-11, thereby decreasing the fiscal year-end General Fund reserve by \$70,000.
