A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING PROVIDING TO THE PUBLIC INFORMATION TO FACILITATE SUCCESSFUL PARTICIPATION IN POSTSECONDARY <u>EDUCATION</u>. 103

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill transfers the college in Colorado division from the department of higher education to the department of education and specifies in statute the duties of the college in Colorado division. The bill also makes conforming amendments.
