Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1178 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 5, strike "REPAID." and substitute "REPAID
- 2 AND THAT IS FIFTY DOLLARS OR MORE."

- 3 Page 3, line 7, strike "INSTITUTION OF HIGHER".

- 4 Page 3, line 8, strike "EDUCATION,".

- 5 Page 3, line 9, after "GOVERNMENT." add ""STATE AGENCY" SHALL NOT
- 6 INCLUDE ANY INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.".

- 7 Page 5, strike lines 17 and 18 and substitute "SOURCE SHALL INCLUDE A
- 8 PROVISION REQUIRING NOTICE OF FUNDING THAT REQUIRES".

- 9 Page 6, strike lines 2 through 7.

- 10 Page 6, line 9, strike "PARAGRAPH (a) OF".

- 11 Page 6, line 14, strike "PARAGRAPH (a) OF".

- 12 Page 6, line 15, strike "EIGHTEEN MONTHS" and substitute "TWO YEARS".

- 13 Page 6, strike lines 20 through 25 and substitute:

- 14 "(5) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2012, AND ON OR BEFORE
- 15 DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF

1 SHALL SUBMIT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE
2 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE MEMBERS OF THE
3 COMMITTEE ON LEGAL SERVICES, AND THE REVISOR OF STATUTES A LIST
4 OF".

5 Page 7, strikes lines 2 through 4 and substitute "CONTAINED IN SUCH
6 BILLS.

7 (6) BEGINNING WITH THE FIRST REGULAR SESSION OF THE
8 SIXTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, COMMENCING IN JANUARY 2013, THE
9 REVISOR OF STATUTES, UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND DIRECTION OF THE
10 COMMITTEE ON LEGAL SERVICES, SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT ANNUALLY
11 ONE OR MORE BILLS CONTAINING THE REPEAL OF THE STATUTORY
12 PROVISIONS CREATED BY THE BILLS INCLUDED ON THE LIST PREPARED
13 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (5) OF THIS SECTION."

14 Page 7, after line 4 insert:

15 **"24-75-1305. Programs or services reliant on grants - statutory**
16 **reauthorization of program.** (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN
17 SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2011, THE
18 GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL NOT MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS
19 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OR FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE OF STATE MONEYS
20 TO FUND A PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER FUNCTION OF STATE
21 GOVERNMENT THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY FUNDED THROUGH GRANT MONEYS
22 AND THAT HAS NOT RECEIVED ADEQUATE GRANT MONEYS TO SUPPORT THE
23 PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER FUNCTION OF STATE GOVERNMENT
24 FOR THE APPLICABLE FISCAL YEAR.

25 (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS
26 SECTION, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2011, A STATE AGENCY THAT OVERSEES
27 ANY PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER FUNCTION OF STATE
28 GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT REQUEST THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAKE
29 AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND OR ANY OTHER SOURCE OF
30 STATE MONEYS TO FUND A PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER
31 FUNCTION OF STATE GOVERNMENT THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY FUNDED
32 THROUGH GRANT MONEYS AND THAT HAS NOT RECEIVED ADEQUATE
33 GRANT MONEYS TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER
34 FUNCTION OF STATE GOVERNMENT FOR THE APPLICABLE FISCAL YEAR.

35 (3) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY ADOPT LEGISLATION TO
36 REAUTHORIZE ANY PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER FUNCTION OF

1 STATE GOVERNMENT THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY FUNDED THROUGH GRANT
2 MONEYS AND, IF SUCH LEGISLATION INCLUDES AN APPROPRIATION FROM
3 THE GENERAL FUND OR ANY OTHER SOURCE OF STATE MONEYS AND
4 BECOMES LAW, MAY MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND
5 OR FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE OF STATE MONEYS TO A STATE AGENCY TO
6 OVERSEE THE PROGRAM, SERVICE, STUDY, OR OTHER FUNCTION OF STATE
7 GOVERNMENT."

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
