A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE ADDRESS OF A PERSON ON FILE WITH SPECIFIED**
102 **STATE AGENCIES, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries>.)

Sections 1 and 2 of the bill require the secretary of state and the department of revenue to include links on their respective official web sites whereby a person who is visiting the official web site of one department may follow the link to the other department's official web site and change his or her address electronically with the second department.

Shading denotes HOUSE amendment. Double underlining denotes SENATE amendment.
*Capital letters indicate new material to be added to existing statute.
Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.*

Section 3 of the bill specifies that a person may update his or her address with the department of revenue electronically via the department of revenue's official web site. Section 3 also defines the term "last-known address" for the purpose of providing certain motor vehicle notices to licensees or registered owners of motor vehicles.

Section 4 of the bill makes a conforming amendment to an internal reference.

Section 5 of the bill specifies that a person who has moved must change the address information for vehicle registration purposes with the county and not the department of revenue.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 1-2-202.5, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
3 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

4 **1-2-202.5. On-line voter registration - on-line changes in**
5 **elector information.** (8) (a) NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2011, THE
6 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE ON THE SECRETARY OF
7 STATE'S OFFICIAL WEB SITE A LINK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE'S
8 OFFICIAL WEB SITE, WHEREBY AN ELECTOR MAY CHANGE HIS OR HER
9 ADDRESS INFORMATION ON FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR
10 DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD PURPOSES.

11 (b) NO SOONER THAN NOVEMBER 1, 2011, AND NO LATER THAN
12 JANUARY 1, 2012, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE ON
13 THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICIAL WEB SITE A LINK TO THE
14 DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE'S OFFICIAL WEB SITE, WHEREBY AN ELECTOR
15 MAY CHANGE HIS OR HER ADDRESS INFORMATION FOR STATE INCOME TAX
16 PURPOSES.

17 **SECTION 2.** 42-1-211, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
18 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

19 **42-1-211. Colorado state titling and registration system.**
20 (1.7) NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2011, THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL

1 MAKE AVAILABLE ON THE DEPARTMENT'S OFFICIAL WEB SITE A LINK TO
2 THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICIAL WEB SITE, WHEREBY A PERSON MAY
3 CHANGE HIS OR HER ADDRESS INFORMATION ON FILE WITH THE SECRETARY
4 OF STATE FOR VOTER REGISTRATION PURPOSES.

5 **SECTION 3.** 42-2-119 (1) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
6 amended, and the said 42-2-119 is further amended BY THE ADDITION
7 OF A NEW SUBSECTION, to read:

8 **42-2-119. Notices - change of address or name.**

9 (1) (a) Whenever any person, after applying for or receiving a driver's
10 license or ~~motor vehicle registration number~~ IDENTIFICATION CARD,
11 moves from the address named in such application or in the license or
12 ~~registration~~ IDENTIFICATION CARD issued to such person or when the name
13 of the licensee is changed, such person shall, within thirty days, ~~notify the~~
14 ~~department in writing~~ PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT of such
15 person's old and new address and the number of any license or
16 ~~registration~~ IDENTIFICATION CARD held by such person. SUCH NOTICE
17 SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE DEPARTMENT IN WRITING OR IN ELECTRONIC
18 FORM ON THE DEPARTMENT'S OFFICIAL WEB SITE. A licensee who changes
19 his or her name shall, within thirty days, apply in person to renew such
20 license pursuant to section 42-2-118 and in compliance with sections
21 42-2-107 and 42-2-305.

22 (2.5) FOR PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION,
23 "LAST-KNOWN ADDRESS" MEANS:

24 (a) FOR NOTIFICATIONS REGARDING MOTOR VEHICLES, THE MOST
25 RECENT ADDRESS PROVIDED ON A VEHICLE REGISTRATION OR VEHICLE
26 REGISTRATION ADDRESS CHANGE NOTIFICATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO
27 SECTION 42-3-113;

1 (b) FOR NOTIFICATIONS REGARDING DRIVING PRIVILEGES, DRIVER'S
2 LICENSES, OR IDENTIFICATION CARDS WHEN THERE IS A DRIVER'S LICENSE
3 OR IDENTIFICATION CARD ON FILE WITH DEPARTMENT, THE MOST RECENT
4 OF EITHER:

5 (I) THE MAILING ADDRESS PROVIDED BY AN APPLICANT FOR A
6 DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD;

7 (II) THE MAILING ADDRESS STATED ON AN ADDRESS CHANGE
8 NOTIFICATION PROVIDED TO THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
9 (1) OF THIS SECTION; OR

10 (III) THE CORRECTED ADDRESS AS REPORTED BY AN ADDRESS
11 CORRECTION SERVICE LICENSED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE;

12 (c) FOR NOTIFICATIONS REGARDING DRIVING PRIVILEGES OR
13 IDENTIFICATION CARDS WHEN THERE IS NO DRIVER'S LICENSE OR
14 IDENTIFICATION CARD ON FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT, THE MOST RECENT
15 ADDRESS SHOWN ON ANY OTHER RECORD ON FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT
16 PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE AND AS MAY BE CORRECTED BY AN ADDRESS
17 CORRECTION SERVICE LICENSED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE.

18 **SECTION 4.** 42-2-307, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
19 to read:

20 **42-2-307. Change of address.** Any registrant who acquires an
21 address different from the address shown on the identification card issued
22 to the registrant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify the department
23 ~~in writing of the registrant's old and new addresses~~ OF SUCH CHANGE AS
24 SPECIFIED IN SECTION 42-2-119 (1) (a). The department may thereupon
25 take any action deemed necessary to ensure that the identification card
26 reflects the proper address of the registrant.

27 **SECTION 5.** 42-3-113 (7), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

1 amended to read:

2 **42-3-113. Records of application and registration.** (7) Within
3 thirty days after moving from an address or changing the name of the
4 owner listed upon a vehicle registration, a person shall notify the
5 ~~department~~ COUNTY OF RESIDENCE IN WHICH THE VEHICLE IS TO BE
6 REGISTERED in writing of the person's old and new address, INCLUDING
7 COUNTY, or old and new name, THE REGISTRATION NUMBERS ASSIGNED
8 TO THE VEHICLES FOR WHICH THE ADDRESS IS BEING CHANGED, and ~~of the~~
9 registration ~~number of~~ NUMBERS FOR all registrations then held by such
10 person.

11 **SECTION 6. Appropriation.** In addition to any other
12 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
13 licensing services cash fund created in section 42-2-114.5, Colorado
14 Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of
15 revenue, for allocation to the division of motor vehicles, driver and
16 vehicle services, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of
17 sixty-three thousand five hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$63,538) cash
18 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of
19 this act.

20 **SECTION 7. Act subject to petition - specified effective date.**
21 This act shall take effect July 1, 2011; except that, if a referendum
22 petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state
23 constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within
24 the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly,
25 then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect unless approved by
26 the people at the general election to be held in November 2010 and shall

- 1 take effect on July 1, 2011, or on the date of the official declaration of the
- 2 vote thereon by the governor, whichever is later.
