After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1204 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 11 through 16 and substitute:
- 2 "(4.5) (a) "CONSERVATION" MEANS EFFICIENCY MEASURES, AS
3 ADOPTED BY THE BOARD, THAT MEET NATIONAL GUIDELINES AND
4 STANDARDS AND ARE TESTED AND APPROVED BY A NATIONALLY
5 RECOGNIZED TESTING LABORATORY, INCLUDING:
- 6 (I) WATER-EFFICIENT DEVICES AND FIXTURES; AND
- 7 (II) THE USE OF LOCALLY PRODUCED MATERIALS, WHEN
8 PRACTICABLE, TO REDUCE TRANSPORTATION IMPACTS.
- 9 (b) WHEN CONSERVATION CONFLICTS WITH SAFETY, THE BOARD
10 SHALL GIVE PRIMARY CONSIDERATION TO SAFETY."
- 11 Page 2, line 17, strike "**date.**" and substitute "**date - applicability. (1)**".
- 12 Page 2, after line 26 insert:
- 13 "(2) The provisions of this act shall apply to a rule modifying the
14 Colorado plumbing code that occurs pursuant to the regular schedule of
15 the examining board of plumbers that is promulgated on or after the
16 applicable effective date of this act."
