SUBJECT:	Intent to Postpone Indefinitely SB10-145

You recently informed our office of your intention to ask the Senate Transportation Committee to postpone indefinitely your bill, SB 10-145, concerning requiring a feasibility study of a rail fixed guideway system between the Auraria higher education center and the Anschutz medical campus of the University of Colorado at Denver. On the basis of this information, we have stopped work on the fiscal note for the bill. If the committee does not PI the bill on April 22, 2010, we will continue to work towards completion of the fiscal note for a committee meeting at a later date.
