#### **Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision <u>reducing</u> General Fund appropriations for FY 2010-11 by \$2,233,182. Specifically, this provision appropriates \$308,628 General Fund and 5.2 FTE to the Judicial Department for probation services, and it reduces General Fund appropriations to the Department of Corrections for payments to house state prisoners by \$2,541,810.

Please note that General Fund savings in FY 2011-12 and subsequent fiscal years, as estimated in Table 3 on page three of the fiscal note, will be reflected in appropriations to the Department of Corrections in the annual general appropriation act for FY 2011-12 and in future fiscal years.
