- 5 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 11 and substitute:

Candidate affidavit - disclosure statement. 6 "1-45-110. 7 (3) Failure of any person to file the affidavit or THE disclosure statement 8 required under this BY SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS section shall result in the disqualification of such person as a candidate for the office being sought. 9 10 Disqualification shall occur only after the appropriate officer DESIGNATED 11 ELECTION OFFICIAL CERTIFYING THE BALLOT PURSUANT TO SECTION 12 1-5-203 (3) (a) has sent a notice to the person by certified mail, return 13 receipt requested, addressed to the person's residence MAILING address. 14 The notice shall state that the person will be disqualified as a candidate 15 if the person fails to file the appropriate document within five business 16 days of receipt of the notice.".
