TITLE: CONCERNING THE RELOCATION OF PROVISIONS RELATING TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH.**Summary of Legislation**

The bill relocates several sections of statute concerning behavioral health, substance abuse treatment, and mental health facilities so that these sections are grouped together in Title 27 of the Colorado Revised Statutes. It is effective upon signature of the Governor or becoming law without his signature.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as no fiscal impact. Relocating these sections of statute will not impact operations at any state agency.
