After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1146 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, line 9, strike "(3), and (5)," and substitute  
2 "and (3),".

3 Page 5, line 11, strike "**allowance as**" and substitute "**allowance.**".

4 Page 5, strike line 12.

5 Page 5, line 13, strike "**department of human services.**".

6 Page 6, strike lines 10 through 15 and substitute "persons ~~eligible to~~  
7 ~~receive~~ WHO MEET THE FUNCTIONAL IMPAIRMENT AND FINANCIAL  
8 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AS ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT BY  
9 RULE AND:

10 (A) WERE RECEIVING old age pension BENEFITS AND HOME CARE  
11 ALLOWANCE ON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF HOUSE BILL  
12 10-1146, AND REMAIN CONTINUOUSLY ELIGIBLE FOR SUCH BENEFITS; OR

13 (B) ARE".

14 Page 8, strike line 15 and substitute:

15 "**SECTION 5.** 26-2-122.3 (5), Colorado Revised Statutes, is  
16 amended to read:

1           **26-2-122.3. Adult foster care and home care allowance as**  
2 **services under certain public assistance programs - administered by**  
3 **department of human services.** (5) The STATE department of health  
4 care policy and financing".

5           Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

6           Page 8, strike lines 20 and 21 and substitute:

7           **"SECTION 6. Specified effective date.** (1) This section and  
8 section 7 of this act shall take effect upon passage.

9           (2) Section 5 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2010.

10           (3) Sections 1 through 4 of this act shall take effect October 1,  
11 2010, or upon the expiration of the provisions of the federal "American  
12 Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009", Pub.L. 111-5, or any  
13 amendment thereto, or other federal law that restricts reimbursement of  
14 an enhanced federal medicaid assistance percentage to a state that reduces  
15 eligibility for its medicaid program, whichever is later, and upon the staff  
16 director of the joint budget committee filing a written notice with the  
17 revisor of statutes that the requirement set forth in this subsection (3) has  
18 been met."

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
