Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$870,155 total funds to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing in FY 2010-11. Of this amount, \$334,227 shall be from the General Fund and \$535,928 shall be from federal funds.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

Points to Consider

The Joint Budget Committee has introduced a balanced budget package for FY 2010-11 based on the March 2010 Legislative Council Staff forecast. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$334,227 for FY 2010-11, thereby decreasing the fiscal year-end General Fund reserve by \$334,227.

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In FY 2011-12, the General Fund impact for this bill will be \$615,143 as delineated in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated February 4, 2010.
