TITLE: CONCERNING THE ALLOCATION OF POWERS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF

CORRECTIONS.

Summary of Legislation

This bill clarifies that the executive director of the Department of Corrections (DOC), and not the director of the Division of Adult Parole in the DOC, supervises and controls the state's correctional facilities. Additionally, the DOC, and not the Division of Parole in the former Department of Institutions, supervises and controls all honor camps, work release programs, and other adult correctional programs. The bill is effective upon the signature of the Governor or upon its becoming law without his signature.

Assessment

The bill will not functionally change the operations of any state department or agency and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
