Updated Analysis

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision indicating that the Governor's Energy Office (GEO) is anticipated to receive \$100,000 in federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds for FY 2010-11. Additionally, **J.001** appropriates \$100,000 transferred from GEO and 1.4 FTE to the Department of Labor and Employment, Division of Employment and Training for FY 2010-11.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

Points to Consider

As noted on page 2 of the March 30, 2010 Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note, the \$250,000 Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funds for this bill will come from funds already anticipated to be received by the Department of Labor and Employment, thus reducing the amount of WIA funds available for other labor market programs by \$250,000 in FY 2010-11 and by \$250,000 in FY 2011-12.
