<u>HB10-1427</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 9, strike "STATE".
- 2 Page 2, line 10, strike "CONTRIBUTIONS FOR".
- 3 Page 2, line 12, strike "ANY".
- 4 Page 2, strike lines 13 through 15 and substitute "contracted for or
 5 administered by the state personnel director for medical, dental, and life
 6 benefits AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 24-50-603 (9).".
- 7 Page 2, after line 15 insert:
- 8 "SECTION 2. 24-50-603 (9), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read:

10 24-50-603. Definitions. As used in this part 6, unless the context
11 otherwise requires:

(9) "Group benefit plans" means any group benefit coverages
contracted for or administered by the director, including but not limited
to, medical, dental, life, and disability benefits. FOR PURPOSES OF
SECTION 24-50-104 (1) (a) (I), "GROUP BENEFIT PLANS" INCLUDES ANY
GROUP BENEFIT COVERAGES OFFERED BY A STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
EDUCATION TO EMPLOYEES OF SUCH INSTITUTION WHO ARE IN THE STATE
PERSONNEL SYSTEM.".

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- 1 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 2 Page 3, strike lines 8 through 16 and substitute:

"education. A STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT HAS, IN 3 4 THE PLAN YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS 5 SECTION, OFFERED ONE OR MORE GROUP BENEFIT PLANS OTHER THAN A 6 PLAN CONTRACTED FOR BY THE DIRECTOR PURSUANT TO THIS PART 6 TO 7 EMPLOYEES OF THE INSTITUTION WHO ARE IN THE STATE PERSONNEL 8 SYSTEM MAY CONTINUE TO OFFER GROUP BENEFIT PLANS TO SUCH 9 NOTHING IN THIS PART 6 SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO EMPLOYEES. 10 OTHERWISE LIMIT OR EXPAND THE AUTHORITY OF ANY INSTITUTION OF 11 HIGHER EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH AND OFFER BENEFIT PLANS TO ITS 12 EMPLOYEES.".

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
