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Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/19/10 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Transportation & Energy Committee 03/02/10)

The House Transportation & Energy Committee Report clarified that ten percent of the moneys in the Adopt a Shelter Pet Account (Account) may be used for administration of the Account.

Legislative Council and JBC Staff are in agreement this amendment does not change the bill's fiscal impact.

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$17,760 cash funds from the License Plate Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles for FY 2010-11.

The Department of Revenue does not require an appropriation of \$1,962 General Fund and \$36,091 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account for computer programming costs as identified in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated February 19, 2010, because the Long Bill includes an appropriation for the Department to implement legislation that requires computer programming hours. Programming costs in the Department to implement legislation will be shown in the Long Bill line item titled "Programming Costs for 2010 Session Legislation."
