## A BILL FOR AN ACT

### 101 CONCERNING AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF MEDICAL GOODS.

#### **Bill Summary**

**Interim Committee on the Developmental Disability Waiting List.** The bill directs the department of health care policy and financing to negotiate agreements with suppliers of high-quality durable medical equipment and medical supplies so that persons receiving public medical benefits or who are on a waiting list for the benefits can purchase high-quality equipment and supplies at the lowest cost. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Part 1 of article 1 of title 25.5, Colorado Revised
Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to
read:

5 **25.5-1-126.** Negotiated purchase agreements - durable medical 6 equipment and supplies. (1)THE STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL 7 NEGOTIATE AGREEMENTS WITH SUPPLIERS OF HIGH-QUALITY DURABLE 8 MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES SO THAT PERSONS ELIGIBLE 9 FOR BENEFITS, OR WHO ARE ON A WAITING LIST TO RECEIVE BENEFITS, 10 UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY PURCHASE HIGH-QUALITY DURABLE MEDICAL 11 EQUIPMENT AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES AT THE LOWEST POSSIBLE PRICE.

12 (2) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT THE
13 SAVINGS REALIZED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT FROM LOWER COSTS FOR
14 DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES BE USED IN PART
15 TO PAY THE COSTS FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT TO NEGOTIATE THE
16 AGREEMENTS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
