3 37 Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Federal Funded Programs -- These federal funds are shown for informational purposes. These funds are not
4 to be included in the spending authority for the Department because these funds do not flow through the accounting system of the state. It is the intent of the
5 General Assembly that these programs, funding, and FTE are included to demonstrate the full scope of activities of the Department of Military and Veterans
6 Affairs.

1 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
2 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
3 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
