A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING INFORMATION IN THE CENTRAL REGISTRY OF
102 PROTECTION ORDERS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill clarifies that the central registry of protection orders shall contain information on the amount of bail and conditions of bond in any case in which the court has entered a protection order and the highest classified crime charged in the case, if any.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 18-6-803.7 (3) (a) (VII), Colorado Revised Statutes,
3 is amended to read:

4 **18-6-803.7. Central registry of protection orders - creation.**

5 (3) (a) In addition to any information, notice, or warning required by law,
6 a protection order or subsequent order entered into the registry shall
7 contain the following information, if such information is available:

8 (VII) The amount of bail, IF ANY, and any conditions of bond
9 ~~which~~ THAT the court has set in the ~~event the restrained person has~~
10 ~~violated~~ a CASE IN WHICH THE COURT ENTERED THE protection order AND
11 THE HIGHEST CLASSIFIED CRIME CHARGED IN THE CASE, IF ANY, AS LISTED
12 IN THE COURT RECORD.

13 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
