Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 18-6-803.7 (3) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH to read:

18-6-803.7. Central registry of protection orders - creation. (3) (a) In addition to any information, notice, or warning required by law, a protection order or subsequent order entered into the registry shall contain the following information, if such information is available:

(VIII) AN INDICATION WHETHER THE CONDITIONS OF THE PROTECTION ORDER ARE ALSO CONDITIONS OF A BAIL BOND FOR A FELONY CHARGE.
