10	CASH FUNDS, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the
11	implementation of this act.
12	(2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
13	appropriated, out of the Colorado unemployment insurance trust fund,
14	created in section 8-77-102 (4), Colorado revised statutes, from moneys
15	distributed in accordance with Section 903 (g) of the federal Social
16	Security Act, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of labor and
17	employment, for allocation to the division of employment and training,
18	for regional workforce center outreach, for the fiscal year beginning July
19	1, 2009, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) FEDERAL
