A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING REPEALING REFERENCES TO THE REFERRAL AND PLACEMENT COMMITTEE TO REFLECT CURRENT USAGE OF INTERDISCIPLINARY TEAMS IN DEVELOPING INDIVIDUALIZED PLANS FOR PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

Bill Summary

The bill updates language and references to the referral and placement committee, which committee duplicates efforts of the

interdisciplinary teams in developing and reviewing individualized plans for persons with developmental disabilities.
